Summary of ADD Activities

2. For each module the completed images for annotation should be emailed to your tutor no later than Monday of the second week of the module.
3. Small Group Online Meetings will be held in the second week of each module, at a time to be negotiated with your tutor. You will be emailed an invitation to attend. The answers to the cases for annotation and additional cases will be discussed along with any questions regarding the module content.

These meetings use the Gotomeeting system and VOIP (voice over Internet protocol) for the audio component. A quiet environment and headset with a microphone is needed.
